(age of Jr in DRAW is determined by Jan 1<sup>st</sup>. Both AERC and UMECRA use DEC. 1 as the date. As it stands, a Jr with an age 16 DEC birthday would be a senior in DRAW and a Jr in UMECRA and AERC. Confusing. It will be affecting more than one Jr rider this year)

What do we want to pay vets for mileage? Max moves and Bill seconds keeping the IRS rate. Passed

Why are hold times varied? Comp riders often have "shortened" times due to having to wait at the vet area. Need better communication/staggering between ride managers and vets.
